I do 99% of the maintenance myself – I am an engineer by day, and a car nut by night/weekend. All maintenance performed to my schedule, not BMW's. Service records available upon request. Imperfections:

Brake pad wear sensors are disabled and tied off (it's easy enough to check pad wear by eye).

BBS wheels have a few scuffs and scratches (not curb rash, it's from tire mounting and from two of the wheels falling over when swapping to winter wheels/tires). When radio was replaced by dealer because of missing pixels, the tech left a few very light scratches in the plastic on the HVAC control panel below the radio.

No door dings (I always park away from other cars).

Overall, I'd conservatively rate both the interior and exterior a 9 out of 10. Can pass for a new car when washed and vacuumed.
